Thank you for contacting Community Unit School District 200 with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

On September 15, 2014 you requested the following documents:

“...the names of the two final candidates for superintendent and their resumes.

This responds to your request. The District is denying your request in its entirety pursuant to FOIA Section 7(1)(c), as only the name and resume of the successful candidate for a position with a public body are subject to disclosure under FOIA. Please be advised that the Illinois Attorney General’s Public Access Counselor (“PAC”) has held in many pre-authorization decisions that the names and resumes of unsuccessful applicants or applicants not hired for a position are exempt from disclosure under FOIA Section 7(1)(c). See 2010 PAC 5196, 2010 PAC 5602, 2010 PAC 5653, 2010 PAC 7800, 2010 PAC 8517, and 2010 PAC 9187.

The undersigned is responsible for the denial of your records request. You may ask the PAC to review this decision concerning your records request, by submitting a Request for Review to the PAC by electronic mail or U.S. Mail within 60 days after this denial of your request. A Request for Review by the PAC should be directed to:
